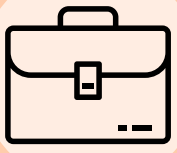


10 STEPS TO DOING UNIVERSITY APPLICATIONS



01. Know what you want to study

Find universities offering your course and compare their requirements, documents required and costs.

Before you apply to ANY university, make sure you know exactly what course you want to study – and whether your school subjects qualify you.



02. Research like a pro



03. Communication

Get all required documents (IDs, results, references, portfolio of evidence, usaf certificate etc) ready, certified, and saved as PDFs.

Use a proper email address and working phone number for easy communication. Attend open days to explore your options.



04. Gather your documents



05. Application Day

Apply to multiple universities to boost your chances of getting accepted.

Pick a day, sit down, and apply to all your chosen universities in one go. Keep application numbers and log in details safe. BE AWARE OF CLOSING DATES!



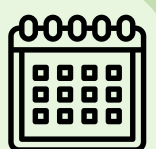
06. Widen your net



07. International Student Advice

Check if your course needs NBTs, then register and prepare early. Remember there is a fee applicable. TIP: do it after your June exams.

Start early to allow time for SAQA/USAf applications, visas, and document processing. Get your finances in order.

09. Awaiting response

Aim to apply to all universities by June so that the second half of the year is focused on Matric Dance, Prelims and Finals.

Keep checking your emails and portals regularly to respond to offers (conditional/provincial acceptances) or fix application mistakes.

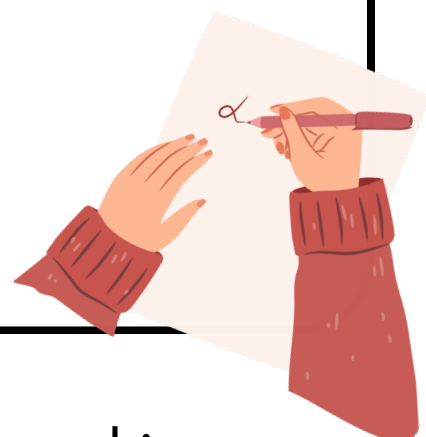


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CHECKLIST

- ☐ Int.Std: apply for USAf certificate
- ☐ Apply and pay for NBT test (if required)
- ☐ Apply for residence and funding
- ☐ Follow up on applications every 2 weeks
- ☐ Int.Std: apply for study visa
- ☐ Accept offers within stipulated timeframes
- ☐ Register for university.
- ☐ Start university!



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
